The evening was a tremendous success and thank you so much for your generous contribution. I'm pleased to tell you that we expect the whole event to have generated over £160,000 after costs for Tildy's Trust and its fight against childhood leukaemia. We will be putting the money to good use in two specific areas:

Cause, prevention and treatment of leukaemia in children and young people

The eradication of this disease relies on cutting-edge scientific research, so we are working closely with **CHILDREN** with **LEUKAEMIA**. This is an established and efficient charity which funds a range of projects mostly in the UK with several in the US. It is important to see knowledge being shared internationally.

We have agreed that Tildy's Trust will take financial stakes in specific research projects rather than putting our whole contribution into one pot. We feel that this gives us a greater level of involvement and transparency.

Patient welfare while in hospital

The treatment of childhood leukaemia involves days and weeks in hospital which is very hard on the sufferers and their families. We are looking into practical ways to help patients, their visitors and carers during their lengthy time in hospital. We have already given DVD players to St. George's, Tooting where Tildy was treated initially and there are many other ways we will be able to help other hospitals.

It is important that the money raised in George Frewer's name should go towards local welfare. Caroline and Martin Frewer are helping us to allocate £25,000 that was raised in the Charity Race this year to go to hospitals local to them.

We will keep the website up-to-date with news, in the meantime thank you so much once again for your kindness and generosity.
